Directions for Matching your Existing CITI Account to Your GT Single Sign On Account (RCR Users)

If you already have a CITI account, matching the account to your Georgia Tech credentials will help ensure that your CITI course completions are properly logged in Georgia Tech's systems. If you have only accessed CITI through Georgia Tech's Single Sign On (SSO) link, you are probably already matched. However, if you have accessed the CITI Program site without using the SSO feature, if you have a CITI account through another institution, or if you have multiple CITI accounts, your account(s) may not be properly matched. Follow the matching instructions below:

1) (IMPORTANT: For security reasons, before clicking the green "button", be sure to close all browser windows and tabs and then reopen your browser. Otherwise you may not get proper credit for your CITI courses.) On the RCR Online Training screen (www.rcr.gatech.edu/online-training) click the green "Begin CITI RCR Training" button:

2) You will be taken to the CAS Login Screen where you will enter your GT Account and Password (if you don't see this screen, follow the instructions in red above):

3) If CITI is able to automatically match your existing CITI account to your Georgia Tech credentials, you will be brought immediately to your CITI main screen – you will see your name in the upper right hand corner (the screen shown below is for example only – what you see may not appear exactly like this).

(If you completed a course at another institution, only the modules with the same ID number will transfer over; you will need to complete any additional modules that Georgia Tech requires.)
- 9) ONE FINAL IMPORTANT STEP: Check that all of your CITI course completions are in your GT CITI SSO Account. If they are not, you may have additional unmatched CITI accounts. In order to have all of your CITI course completions recorded in Georgia Tech's systems, your other CITI account(s) will need to be merged into your GT SSO CITI Account.
