Checking RCR Degree Requirement Statuses in DegreeWorks

In DegreeWorks, you can check RCR degree requirement statuses for the:

- RCR Academic Policy for Doctoral Students and
- RCR Academic Policy for Master's Thesis Students

It's important to be aware that since the primary purpose of the DegreeWorks system is to check degree progress, it does not necessarily show all RCR training records for all students. For example, attendance at an RCR workshop is not shown in DegreeWorks; master's thesis students will only have one of three RCR training options shown. Also, the system does not show RCR training information for non-thesis master's students or for doctoral students under a Catalog Year prior to 2011-12.

I. DOCTORAL STUDENTS

Doctoral students admitted Fall 2011 or later will show two RCR degree requirements in DegreeWorks:

- 1) RCR Online Training
- 2) RCR Doctoral Course

If either or both requirements have been satisfied, there will be a green checkmark by the type of training (see Example A).

If either or both requirements have NOT been satisfied, there will be a note indicating "Still Needed" (see Example B).



II. DOCTORAL STUDENTS - EXCEPTIONS / FORCE COMPLETES

Doctoral students who are **not covered by the Academic RCR Policy** but who are under a 2011-12 or later Catalog Year will show the RCR doctoral degree requirements in DegreeWorks. If these students have taken the relevant training, the completion(s) will appear in DegreeWorks. If they have not completed the training (and the RCR Administrator or Registrar has added an Exception in DegreeWorks), a "Force Complete – Not Required per the Doctoral RCR Policy" notice will appear.

Example - Doctoral Student admitted prior to Fall 2011 (i.e., not covered by the RCR Academic Policy for Doctoral Students) who has completed a Doctoral RCR Course but not the Online Training. A "Force Complete" has been added:



Important Note: An exception in DegreeWorks does NOT mean that the student has been exempted from the RCR training requirements of the RCR Compliance Policy, which applies to applicable NSF, NIH or USDA-NIFA grants. III. MASTER'S THESIS STUDENTS

Master's students who are pursuing a thesis will show ONLY ONE RCR degree requirement in DegreeWorks:*

RCR Requirement

If the degree requirement has been satisfied, there will be a green checkmark by "RCR Requirement" and ONE of the three options completed by the student will be shown.

If the degree requirement has NOT been satisfied, there will be a note indicating "Still Needed".

Master's Thesis RCR Degree Requirement Satisfied via Option 1 - This indicates that at a minimum, the RCR Online Training has been completed. Other training options may also have been completed but are not indicated here:



Master's Thesis RCR Requirement Satisfied via Option 2 - At a minimum, an RCR Doctoral Course has been completed:

Master's Thesis RCR Requirement Satisfied via Option 3 - At a minimum, an RCR Master's Course has been completed:



RCR Requirement Still Needed (none of the three Master's Thesis Options have been completed):



*Important Note: The RCR Master's Thesis Policy only requires ONE form of RCR training: Option (1) an online RCR course, Option (2) a doctoral RCR course, or Option (3) a master's RCR course. If more than one of these three options for master's students and/or RCR Workshops have been completed, that is not currently reflected in DegreeWorks.
