However, some of the completion data may be helpful for checking whether the RCR training for a funding source has been completed (*RCR Compliance Status Reports, which will include in-person contact hours, are currently in development*).



*IMPORTANT NOTES REGARDING "RQ":

For the RCR Compliance Policy, an "RQ" or the lack thereof in Banner **does NOT** indicate whether the individual has an RCR Compliance training requirement. Refer instead to <u>http://www.rcr.gatech.edu/compliance-applicability.</u>

For the RCR Academic Policy for Doctoral Students, the **degree** requirement does not apply to doctoral students admitted prior to Fall 2011 or to master's students admitted prior to Fall 2011 who transition directly to a doctoral program. The degree requirement does not apply to those who have transitioned permanently to a master's program.
