

## Checking RCR Training Status in Banner

The Banner **SHANCRS** module (“Academic Non-Courses”) displays completions of the following RCR training components:

- **Online CITI RCR Training** [www.rcr.gatech.edu/online-training](http://www.rcr.gatech.edu/online-training)
- **Doctoral RCR Courses** [www.rcr.gatech.edu/doctoral-courses](http://www.rcr.gatech.edu/doctoral-courses)
- **Master’s RCR Courses** [www.rcr.gatech.edu/masters-courses](http://www.rcr.gatech.edu/masters-courses)

The information in SHANCRS is primarily intended for the purposes of the Doctoral and Master’s Thesis RCR policies. However, some of the completion data may be helpful for checking whether the RCR training for a funding source has been completed (*RCR Compliance Status Reports, which will include in-person contact hours, are currently in development*).

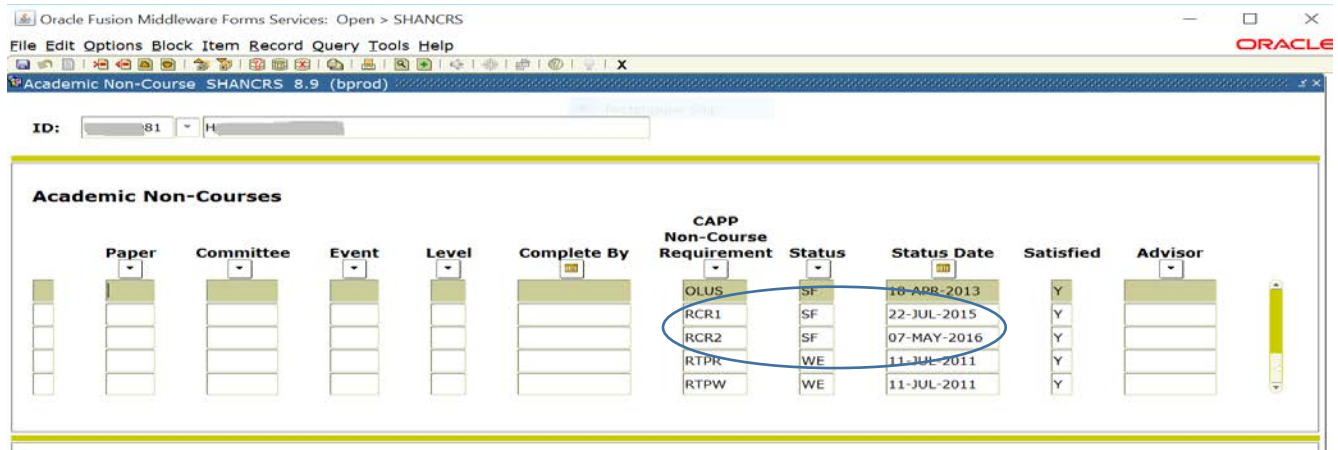
**RCR Statuses in Banner are indicated as follows:**

Code	Status	Status Meaning	Status Date Meaning
RCR1	SF	<b>Online CITI RCR Course Completed</b> (for students, postdocs, faculty, and staff with GT login credentials)	Date course was completed
RCR1	RQ*	<b>Online CITI RCR Course Required</b>	First day of effective term of the degree requirement
RCR2	SF	<b>Doctoral RCR Course Completed</b>	Last day of the semester that the course was completed
RCR2	RQ*	<b>Doctoral RCR Course Required</b>	First day of effective term of the degree requirement
RCR3	SF	<b>Master’s RCR Course Completed</b>	Last day of the semester that the course was completed
RCR1, RCR2, and/or RCR3	Not Present	<b>The course has not been completed</b>	N/A

**\*IMPORTANT NOTES REGARDING “RQ”:**

**For the RCR Compliance Policy**, an “RQ” or the lack thereof in Banner **does NOT** indicate whether the individual has an RCR Compliance training requirement. Refer instead to <http://www.rcr.gatech.edu/compliance-applicability>.

**For the RCR Academic Policy for Doctoral Students**, the **degree** requirement does not apply to doctoral students admitted prior to Fall 2011 or to master’s students admitted prior to Fall 2011 who transition directly to a doctoral program. The degree requirement does not apply to those who have transitioned permanently to a master’s program. It also does not apply to readmits who officially began their doctoral program prior to Fall 2011. **Example:**

**RCR 1 SF** = Online CITI RCR Course - completed 7/22/2015

**RCR 2 SF** = Doctoral RCR Course - completed Spring 2016 semester
